## **BUCKLEY'S HARTFORD, CT VP/GM TO RETIRE**

(Greenwich, CT – December 5, 2007) Buckley Radio announced today that **Wayne Mulligan**, Vice President and General Manager, will retire at the end of the year after 38 years at WDRC and Buckley's other Connecticut stations. Mulligan began his career at WDRC in 1964 as an engineer. In 1966, he moved to WTIC as studio engineer and in 1972 was appointed Chief Engineer at WDRC. He was promoted to Station Manager in 1989 and has held the position of General Manager since 1991.

Additionally, Mulligan has served on the board of the Connecticut Broadcasters Association for 10 years and was its chairman for 3 years. He is president of the board of the Connecticut Radio Information System for the blind and print handicapped. He served on the Windsor, CT Town Council for 6 years, and working with Former Governor John Rowland, he was instrumental in Connecticut being the fifth state in the nation to have an AMBER plan.

Rick Buckley, President and CEO of Buckley Radio said, "Wayne has been a great friend and an enduring asset to Buckley Radio. We hope that he and his family will enjoy their retirement years."

Mulligan stated, "I have been able to be involved in serving the people of Connecticut because Rick Buckley and his father before him have instilled the sense of service in all who work in this company. It has been my distinct pleasure to be able to lead the five great radio stations which Rick owns in Connecticut."

**Eric Fahnoe** will assume the position of Vice President and General Manager of the five Buckley Broadcasting Connecticut stations. Fahnoe began his career in radio at the Buckley stations in Monterey, California, before moving to Connecticut. Eric is a current board member and past president of the Rotary Club of Bloomfield, CT. He is a graduate of San Jose State University and a member of Delta Tau Delta fraternity. He and his wife Michelle live in Vernon, Connecticut.
